

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



Of the Norman Cathedral, completed in 1092, only the west front and the lower part of the west towers remain. Most of the present building was erected between 1192 and 1280 and owes its inspiration, as the first Gothic church in Britain, to the great St. Hugh. It is famous for its commanding position and great wealth of superb carving in wood and stone.
